A Bris (convent) is sealed between Hashem and Klall Yisroel, that he will not exchange us, and we will not exchange Him, Chas VeSholom. Included in this Bris is if a Yid feels a detachment from Hashem Yisborach, - Zohl ehr zich gleich tzurik chapin – he should immediately attach himself - to Hashem.

Once The Rebbe Reb Bunim of Parshischa ZY"A, asked The Heilige Chozeh of Lublin ZY"A, "Is it true as the Rebbe says that if a person realizes his worth and the judgement of his soul, it is as the world says – in the time that one makes his calculations with his friends, after the calculation it is like half paid? – Calculated is half payment". The Chozeh ZY"A, answered "Yes", it is a Svoroh (analysis). Just as one has stock from out of the country, (treife schoiroh). If the King puts his seal on it becomes Kosher, so too, one who recognizes himself what he truthfully is, then it is called upon him the Name of The King of all Kings Hakodosh Boruch Hu, whose seal is truth and he becomes Kosher. (understand since it is deep)

In all their troubles He was troubled, so an angel from before Him saved them. With His love and and with His compassion, He redeemed them, He lifted them, and bore them all the days of the world. [63:9]

The written is "lo with an Alef (no)", and the reading is "lo with a Vov (to Him)". Since it is "Loi tzor" Hashem Yisborach is pained with us in our troubles. He is with us in our exile. It is therefore "Lo tzur" (not a pain), it is not a trouble and exile, since Hashem is with us, therefore the trouble is not a trouble. If our Father is here with us, the child does not have what to fear.
