



## <u>מדרגת אהרן</u>

After the tragic passing of the two sons of אהרון הכהן אהרון (י', ג'), אירון הכהן עוידם אהרון (י', ג'). Why did the תורה use this word and not simply "ושתק אהרון" like translation of the תרגום?

The מאיר עיני הכמים explains that this word is matter without any life, such as a rock or a piece of earth. Had the תורה used the term "ושתק", it would mean he kept quiet but nevertheless inside he was changed, he was broken, he wasn't the same as before.

The תורה is telling us "וידם אהרן", he was like a דומם, just like when you smash a rock and break it, nothing has really changed, so too by אהרן הכהן nothing had changed, he was the same as before unaffected due to his great מדרגה. Smashing a rock is different than when you break a tree or a plant or something with real life in it, when smashing something with real life, it is completely different afterwards, the life has gone away.

The תורה is מרמז תחיית המתים in the first word of the מרמז חז"ל as חז"ל teach us why the מערה uses a תורה dwill sing, "אז ישיר משה" of לשון in future tense, this is coming to teach us that not only did משה and כלל ישראל sing at that time שירה, but they "will sing" again שירה מלודה after תחיית המתים. Why is this the place where the ant araז araז this important message?

This ברכה should always be a היזוק for us when we suffer a loss or hear about someone else's loss or hear about a terrorist attack, the present physical life that we know is only a small fraction of our existence, our existence is eternal and we will be reunited again in the future.
